- Acknowledge that I am entering a wildlife area, that I will be travelling by vehicle over uneven and potentially hazardous terrain, that I will be staying in an unfenced camp and that my stay at Kapula may take or bring me into close contact with wild and dangerous animals;
- Acknowledge that my venture to Kapula Private Camp, including all travelling to and from and within the wildlife area is entirely at my own risk;
- Release Matijoni Investments (Pvt) Ltd from all and any liability and waive all and any claims of whatsoever nature and however arising, which may arise from any cause whatsoever during the period of my stay at Kapula Private Camp and Hwange National Park including without limitation those acts of passive or active negligence on the part of Matijoni Investments (Pvt) Ltd, its offices and/or Employees;
- Indemnify and agree to hold harmless Kapula Private Camp against all and any claims of whatsoever nature and howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever during the period of my visit to Kapula Private Camp, including all traveling to, from and within Hwange National Park, which any one or more of my dependants or any third party may have, including but not limited to, claims arising from my death, personal injury or loss or damage to my possessions;
- Agree to adhere to all regulations which may be brought to my attention during the period of my visit to Kapula Private Camp, by either the management, guides or any other employee of Kapula Private Camp and Hwange National Park;
- I furthermore agree to comply with all Rules and Regulations pertaining to the Hwange National Park as published by the Zimbabwe National Wildlife Authority;
- Without derogating from the generality of the foregoing, acknowledge that Kapula Private Camp shall not be liable to me or any of my dependants, relatives or guests for any injury, illness, harm, loss of support, consequential loss, damage or damages of whatsoever nature that may be sustained from any cause whatsoever (including but not limited to negligence and/or fault) during my visit to Kapula Private Camp and Hwange National Park;
- Acknowledge and agree that any claims, be they in contract, delict or otherwise, instituted against Matijoni Investments (Pvt) Ltd shall be governed by the laws of Zimbabwe and may only be instituted in a Zimbabwe Court to the exclusion of all other jurisdictions.

Dear Guest,

Welcome to *Kapula Private Camp*. We hope that you will thoroughly enjoy your stay at *Kapula*. Our friendly Staff will assist with any queries you might have. In order to make your stay as pleasant as possible please note the following:

Safety Talk

As a guest of Kapula Private Camp we acknowledge that we received the following safety talk:

1. **Camp Layout**
 - Main lounge, dining room area, guest tents and surroundings.
2. **Safety**
 - **When going to North Camp Tent 1, 2 and Guide Tent after dark, it is imperative to drive to the tents as dangerous animals may be present** • No fences • Stay on designated paths – do not stray off the walkway and walk in the bush • Decked areas can be slippery – rain and/or morning dew • Keep alert during the day • Early evening and morning, safe to walk on your own to main area/room unless advised otherwise by staff • Lions and other dangerous animals regularly visit the Camp. Please be extra vigilant during day and night • Please do not sit or lean on the balustrades or railings. • No walking by yourself at night after dinner to Tent 1 & 2 – use your vehicle • Torches / Flashlights.
3. **Emergency**
 - Fog Horn in room for emergencies
4. **Electricity**
 - Solar/Battery System – 24 hr electricity • Use power sparingly • In summer, switch of lights – attracts insects • Can charge cell phone, camera, computer batteries in main building • The Solar System is not suitable for Hairdryers, etc. and use thereof will result in no power to the Whole Camp • Switch off all lights when not in use and ensure that all lights are switched off in Kitchen / Dining and Walkways area when going to bed.
5. **Laundry**
 - No laundry facilities available • Do no hang things outside your tent – use outside Shower area.
6. **Water**
 - Safe to drink tap water and ice • Hot water system – heated by solar panels • “Donkey” Boiler
7. **Security**
 - No safety deposit boxes – Keep valuables locked in Vehicles.
8. **Staff Duties**
 - Staff will ensure that Tents and Main Building are serviced daily - do Washing Up, make Fire for Hot Water and at Fire Pit area as required.
9. **Fire**
 - **Fire is a major Hazard to Staff, Guests and Wildlife in the dry season, both around the camp and within the National Park.**
 - Fire Pit – Remove logs and dowse with water • Put ½ drum over coals before going to bed as wind during the night can start bush fires • Blow out all Paraffin Lamps • Fire Extinguisher placed on the side of the room headboard • Fire procedure – Evacuate, raise alarm and call staff • The Evacuation Meeting Point is the Vehicle Parking area.
10. **Read**
 - Guest information brochure in your tent
11. **Smoking**
 - **No smoking** in: Tents, Main Building • Smoke only outside at the Fire Pit area and ensure cigarettes are carefully disposed of and not on ground.
12. **Forms**
 - Sign and fill in Registration / Indemnity form.
13. **Feeding of animals**
 - Under no circumstances feed any wildlife – you will sign their death warrant by doing so.
14. **Obey all National Park Rules**
15. **Read Notices in Kitchen regarding use of all appliances**
16. **Please report any breakages or Maintenance items to Staff.**
