Important Notice to Kapula guests

Beware – wild animals are very dangerous!

In the event of any emergency, please blow the emergency whistle located in the tent

- ☞ When walking in the camp area, especially at night, beware of wild animals. Unless an experienced game scout is available to escort guests to their rooms at night, a vehicle should be used to transfer to the tents.
- ☞ Beware of snakes and try to keep your doors closed at all times.
- ☞ You may not leave the immediate camp area at ANY time unless escorted by a guide.
- ☞ If a staff member is not immediately available, please wait for his or her arrival.
- ☞ To summon a staff member, please use the whistle provided in each tent.
- ☞  NO SMOKING is allowed in the tents and main buildings as this is a fire hazard.
- ☞ Please take note of the locations of the fire-fighting equipment.
- ☞ As this is a malaria area, the necessary precautions must be taken, i.e. use the nets at night, spray repellent and take the necessary prophylactics as recommended by your doctor.
- ☞ Please use the water, gas and electricity very sparingly. Electricity is generated from batteries and solar panels and will be depleted if not used very carefully.
- ☞ **Under NO circumstances** must any animals be fed around camp or encouraged to visit the camp in any way whatsoever. These animals will soon become problematic and would have to be shot. Do not be responsible in this way for the death sentence of any of these precious animals.
