

Important Notice to Kapula guests

Beware – wild animals are very dangerous!

In the event of any emergency, please blow the emergency whistle located in the tent

- ☐ When walking in the camp area, especially at night, beware of wild animals. Unless an experienced game scout is available to escort guests to their rooms at night, guest's vehicles should be used to transfer to the tents.
- ☐ Beware of snakes and try to keep your doors closed at all times.
- ☐ You may not leave the immediate camp area on foot at ANY time unless escorted by a National Parks registered guide.
- ☐ **NO SMOKING is allowed in the tents and main buildings.**
- ☐ Please take note of the locations of the fire-fighting equipment and take special precautions in the dry season to prevent fires in the camps and on game drives.
- ☐ As this is a malaria area, the necessary precautions must be taken.
- ☐ Please use the water, gas and electricity very sparingly. Electricity is generated from batteries and solar panels and will be depleted if not used very carefully. Hairdryers, kettles and other electrical appliances are not allowed in either camp.
- ☐ **Under NO circumstances** must any animals or birds be fed around camp or encouraged to visit the camp in any way whatsoever. These animals will soon become problematic and would have to be shot. Do not be responsible in this way for the death sentence of any of these precious animals or birds.

On arrival guests will be required to register and sign an indemnity form(copies of this are available on request.)
